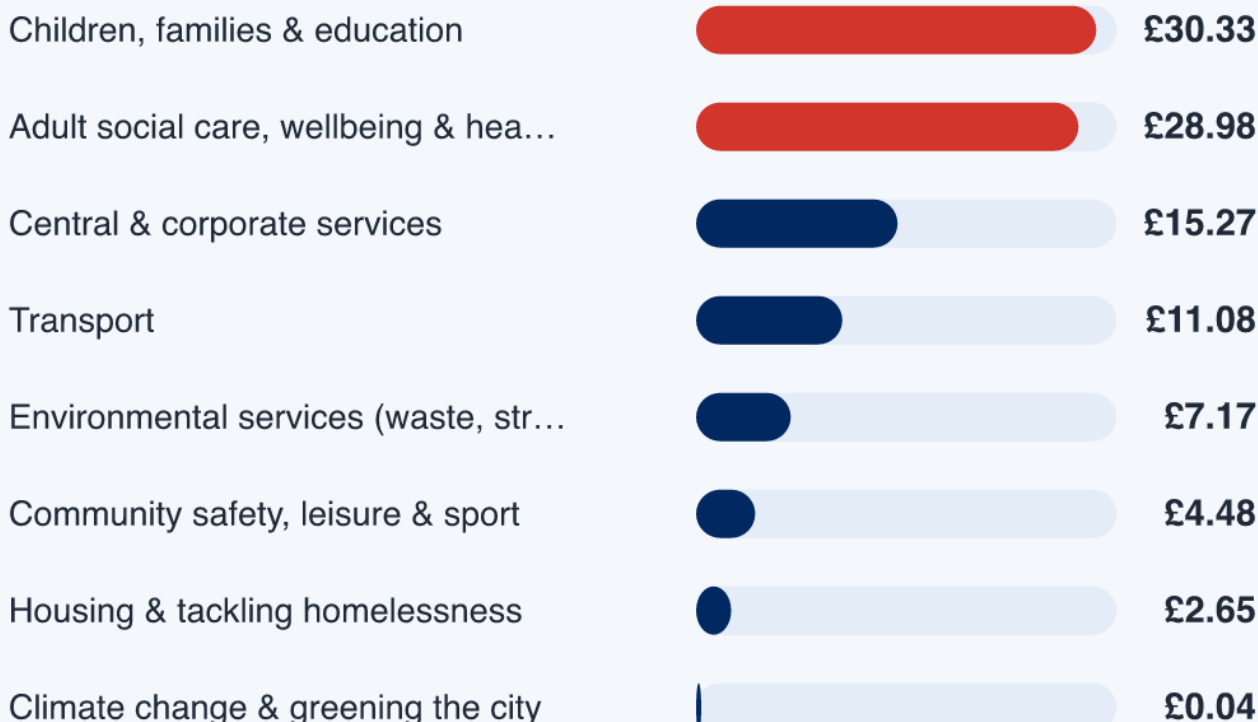


Where £100 of Portsmouth City Council service spending goes

Of every £100 Portsmouth City Council spends on services: Children, families & education £30.33; Adult social care, wellbeing & health £28.98; Central & corporate services £15.27; Transport £11.08; Environmental services (waste, streets) £7.17; Community safety, leisure & sport £4.48; Housing & tackling homelessness £2.65; Climate change & greening the city £0.04. ~60p in every £1 goes on children's services and adult social care (2025/26 service budgets).
